Professor **James B. Rowe** was appointed as the Professor of Cognitive Neurology at the University of Cambridge and an affiliated Professor of Clinical Neuroscience at the University of Copenhagen in Denmark.

He trained in Cambridge and at the University of Oxford (1991-1994) and obtained a PhD at the Functional Imaging Laboratory of the Wellcome Department of Cognitive Neurology (1998-2001), supervised by Professor Richard Frackowiak and Professor Dick Passingham.

His PhD focused on the neural mechanisms of response selection and attention to action, in health and Parkinson's disease, using human neuroimaging techniques, such as positron emission tomography, functional magnetic resonance imaging (fMRI), and repetitive transcranial magnetic stimulation (TMS).

During his clinical training he continued research, including clinical experience with Frontotemporal dementia.

He works for the better understanding, diagnosis and treatment of degenerative brain diseases, including dementia and parkinsonian disorders, bringing together computational models of brain and behaviour, physiology (MEG), structural and functional brain imaging (3T and 7T), and biomarkers of pathology (PET/blood), genetics and experimental treatments.

He is an active consultant neurologist, leading regional specialist clinics for patients with early dementia, frontotemporal dementia, Progressive Supranuclear Palsy, and other 'tauopathies', and he is a consultant in the Cambridge Memory Clinic.
